Since 1987 the AHS Foundation has awarded scholarships to Alliance High School seniors.

Scholarships awarded through the Foundation to the 2011 graduating class totaled \$ 83,800, bringing the total amount granted over the last 25 years to \$ 673,850. From a meager beginning in 1987 of one \$ 500 scholarship to this year's awards to 27 recipients, including the Academic Top Ten Percent awards, more than 800 AHS graduating seniors have benefited from Foundation scholarships. This could not have been accomplished without the support of thousands of alumni and friends of Alliance High.

AHS Foundation Presents Three \$10,000 Klusch Scholarships

Since its inception ten years ago, the endowment established by the late John and Roene Klusch has given the AHS Foundation the opportunity to support some remarkable graduating seniors.

Like the other scholarships in the Foundation's family of funds, the Klusch awards began with a one-time gift, so it was indeed a milestone for us when we were able to create renewable awards that help students meet their financial needs throughout their four years of college. The 2011 Klusch awards are for \$10,000.00 each.

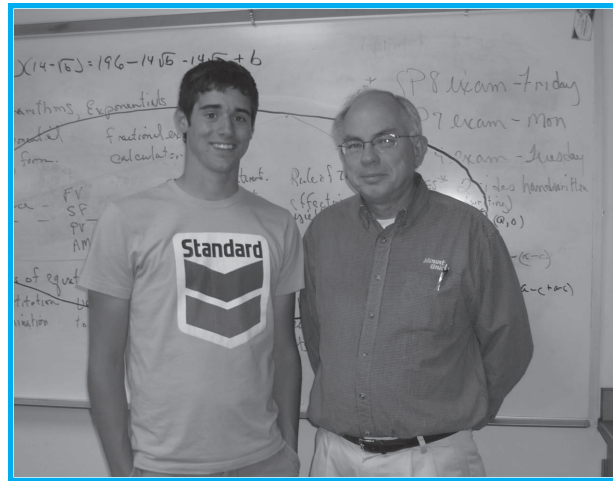
AHS Foundation Will Administer Carli-Cowan Scholarship Endowment

The Mathematics Department at Alliance High School has chosen the AHS Foundation to administer the endowment funds for the newly named Carli-Cowan Scholarship Fund.

Annually, for more than 20 years, the Mathematics department has awarded a scholarship to a student who has excelled in Math and who will be studying in a mathematics related field in college. This scholarship fund has grown through donations from former students, colleagues, friends and family members of two outstanding members of the department, Bill Carli and Dave Cowan.

Dave Cowan began teaching in 1954 at Stanton Jr High, later moving to the high school to chair the mathematics department. He often counseled students about their future plans, sharing thoughts about opportunities available to them. He was a coach, cheerleader and motivator. He also mentored new teachers, offering advice, friendship and a listening ear to their concerns. Dave shared his experiences and encouraged them to become better teachers through the educational opportunities available. He advocated involvement in local, state and national educational organizations. The current math department chair at AHS, Cynthia Vickers, served AHS students as a student teacher in Dave's class. Dave was only 46 when he died in 1978, but his impact on both students and fellow teachers is remembered fondly.

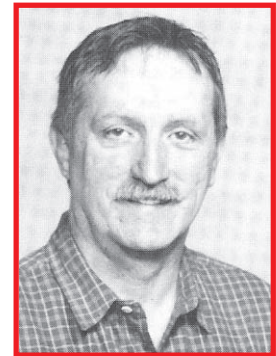
Bill Carli '65 took Dave's advice about furthering creative ways of teaching students. Bill became a self-taught computer programming teacher. He shared his projects and strategies with other teachers at local, state and national meetings.

Several of his projects have been published in trade magazines. In later years, Bill took on the challenge of becoming a mentor to teachers throughout Stark County. He spent five years as the Alliance School systems math coach for both the high school and the middle school and he taught demonstration classes and helped other teachers prepare lesson plans. Bill's patience, expertise and experience were evident as he encouraged students to extend themselves to achieve in mathematics. Bill's untimely death in 2008 is still felt by many students and teachers, and he is missed.

The Mathematics department will continue to select the annual recipient of the Carli-Cowan Award, to be presented during the AHS Senior Awards Assembly. The AHS Foundation board appreciates the confidence expressed by the Math Department in choosing the Foundation to administer this endowment. ✈

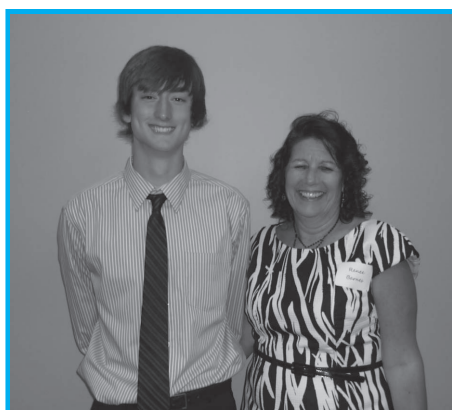

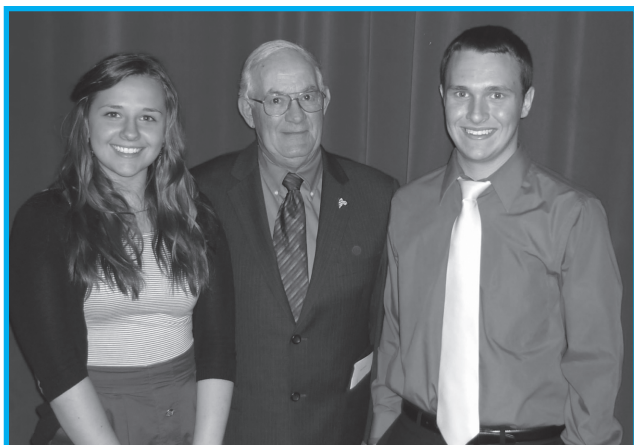

Top Ten Percent Academic Team at Alliance High School 2011

Alliance High School's 'Top 10 %' of the Class of 2011 were awarded Academic letters at the annual Academic Recognition dinner last May. Mark Fedor '89, President and CEO of Morgan Engineering, Inc, was the featured speaker. Mark spent a day at AHS interacting with students and teachers in their classroom settings and as speaker at the annual Awards assembly, along with his presentation at the dinner.

Mr. Fedor graduated from Alliance High School in 1986 and from Akron University's School of Engineering in 1994. He challenged the students, saying, "great things are done by people like us, aspire to do great things!" He encouraged the students to try a variety of things to discover what you really like, your curiosity will shape your life, do not give up, things will change, expect changes, new technologies are being developed every second, you start being an adult when you take responsibility for your life and great questions and ideas congeal over time.

The academic achievements of each student were recognized as each was presented a certificate and a Varsity letter. The parents of the students were introduced, along with the student's 'honored educator,' chosen by the student as someone who has been most instrumental in the realization of their academic success. Each of the top ten percent received a \$200 cash award from the AHS Foundation.

The Academic Recognition Committee was established in 1987 and is self-supporting.

The Committee's goals are:

- Motivation of students to perceive academic excellence as a worthwhile goal
- Establishment of a means of honoring students for academic excellence
- Search for ongoing support to fund programs that generate a climate of acceptance of academic excellence among students, their parents, the community, and educators.
