**M**organ Elementary School opened its doors September 1957 with 23 staff members and 594 students, grades K-6. The school was located on the corner of East Garwood and Morgan Avenue, behind Alliance Machine, known to many in the community as Goat Hill.

The first principal was Mr. William Lane. Some of the first Morgan teachers were Mrs. Flood, Mrs. Collins, Mrs. Elton, Mrs. Brown, Mrs. Truby, Mrs. Hazen, Mrs. Scott and Miss Crawford.

The school was one floor, shaped like a giant U, connecting the primary and intermediate wings with the office, clinic and library. In the early years, Morgan had a full cafeteria. The wonderful smells of lunch being prepared greeted each person upon entering the building every morning.

In 1970, Mr. Lane retired and Mr. David Maxwell became the new principal. The Thanksgiving Feast became a tradition at the school in the mid -70's. The students and teachers dressed as Pilgrims and Indians. Each class prepared a simple food to share along with skits, poems and stories.

Each year classes took turns presenting the Thanksgiving, Christmas and Spring programs on stage. Memorable programs were the Bi-Centennial in 1976 and the 25<sup>th</sup> birthday of Mickey Mouse. Each year the students and teachers looked forward to the Christmas program presented by music teachers Mrs. Weitzel and Mrs. Cross. How many remember Mrs. Kolm's reading center? Children enjoyed reading their favorite books in the reading bathtub.

In 1982, Mr. Francis Carr became principal of Morgan School. Later when he was elected Mayor of Alliance, Mrs. Nancy Kile completed the year and

continued on as principal until 1988. In the 90's, with Mrs. Wanda Chidsey as principal, Morgan School integrated creative arts (art, music and dance) into all subject areas. Additionally every other year, children presented musical, dance and artistic talents in a dinner theater setting.

The following are memories of two former Morgan students.

"I had the privilege to be a Morgan Bear from the years 1984-1990. I remember the enjoyment of going to the library and having Mrs. Rose read stories to us. I remember watching The Letter People, Reading Rainbow, and 3-2-1 Contact. I remember playing Oregon Trail, Number Munchers, and Where in the World Is Carmen Sandiego? on the computer that required a three inch floppy disk. I remember being a safety patrol and having the privilege of making sure other students crossed the streets safely. I remember dressing up as McGruff the Crime Dog for a school assembly. I remember enjoying Ruth Chew books and eating a special birthday meal of pizza with other classmates and Mrs. Kulieke and playing popcorn with a parachute in gym class. I remember Mr. Smith, our custodian, who was one of the nicest people I have ever known. These are just a few of my dear memories of Morgan Elementary. I consider myself lucky to have attended such a wonderful school with wonderful teachers and staff".

### Saffell Scholarship Increased to \$2,500

John Saffell '34 has stepped up again to help Alliance High School graduates continue their education beyond high school. The AHS Foundation board has voted to increase this year's Byron E & Isabel Anderson Saffell Scholarship to \$2,500, to be awarded to a member of the Class of 2012 who has demonstrated an interest in History.

This increase is prompted by an additional \$10,000 gift from John Saffell in February of 2012. This is the third time since the initial \$50,000 donation in 2000 that Mr. Saffell has added an additional \$10,000 to the scholarship endowment.

A total of \$16,000 has been awarded to 11 students since the first award in 2001. The board appreciates Mr. Saffell's generosity and support for AHS graduates and the confidence he shows in the AHS Foundation scholarship program.

In other action, the board approved scholarship distribution to be awarded to the AHS Class of 2012 of more than \$80,000 from funds administered by the AHS Foundation. ✈

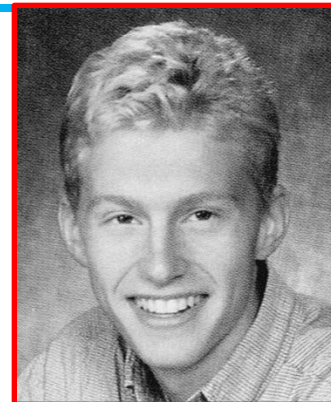

## Curtis Lundgren '99

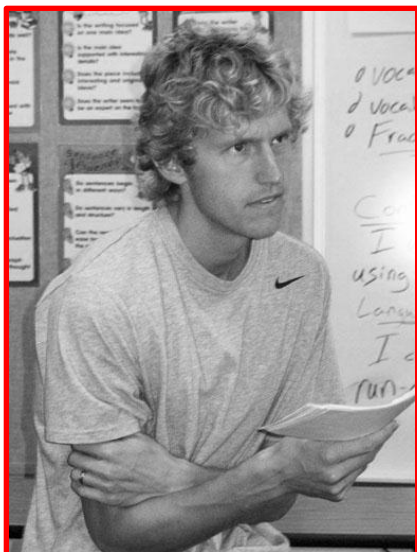
We got an address change from the post office for Curtis Lundgren after the last newsletter was mailed. He moved from Texas to Ottumwa, Iowa.

Now if you watched television in the past 50 years, it is likely that you know someone from Ottumwa, Iowa! I pause a moment to allow the 'trivial information section' of your brain to get in gear... Remember MASH? Remember Radar O'Reilly? Radar was from Ottumwa, Iowa.

I couldn't hold back my curiosity. What is in Ottumwa besides Uncle Ed's farm? I called Curtis' mom, Cheryl, and she gave me the story, with all the trimmings. Curtis graduated at AHS in 1999. He graduated from Wittenberg as an English major with an emphasis in poetry. Just this past year, he graduated from UTEP (University of Texas El Paso) with a Masters Degree in Education.

Mom goes on to tell me that while he was "finding himself," there were a lot of experiences along the way. These may not be in the right order, but there was a time, following up on his experiences with the Wind River Science Club at AHS, he did some hiking 'out west' in several National Parks, a wedding to Anna, who he met at Wittenberg, four years in the Army with a tour in Iraq (awarded a Silver Star for his actions under fire to save a wounded squad member, and was wounded himself, in 2007), a hike of the Appalachian Trail from Alabama to the Maine border (almost the entire distance-Curtis had to end the hike to get back for brother Scott's, class of '96, wedding), a daughter, Sonya, now 2 ½ and January 13, 2012, a son Eli, and now, Ottumwa, Iowa, teaching middle school English.

While serving in Iraq and hiking the trails of America, Curtis read extensively, even carrying a book along the Appalachian Trail and using previously read chapters to start his evening fire. He made his decision to become a teacher. Upon graduation, he interviewed around UTEP and on a trip to visit Anna's family north of Ottumwa, he made a cold call and got an interview with the Superintendent of Ottumwa Schools. Geographically, Ottumwa is due west of Columbus, Ohio. It is a town similar to Alliance in size.

Curtis got the job teaching seventh grade English, with the principal responsibility for grammar and writing. To start the year, Curtis was assigned, as one of the new teachers in the Ottumwa system, to be interviewed by a local television station. The title for the interview was "Veteran-Teacher." Al Eibel, now retired AHS teacher, was a major influence on Curtis. Mr. Eibel's Biology and Science assignments also doubled as English and grammar studies. If your language skills were not up to standard, your science grade could suffer!

In Ottumwa, the Middle School sponsors trips for their students. The sixth graders go for a weekend trip to St Louis, the eighth graders take a ten day trip to Washington DC and the seventh graders travel west to hike in a National Park. We envision Curtis being a willing volunteer to chaperone those hiking trips. The Wind River experience and all of life's experiences should hold Curtis in good stead as he shares knowledge with his seventh grade classes and explores Radar's hometown.

A Post Script (P. S.): While in Iraq, Curtis says he watched nearly all the episodes of MASH on the Armed Forces Network! ✈
