he family of Theresa Utterback has established a \$25,000.00 endowment to honor their late mother through a scholarship to graduating Alliance High School seniors.

The scholarship will total \$4,000.00, with the distribution being made as follows: \$1,000.00 prior to the first year of college, \$1,000.00 prior to the second year of college and \$2,000.00 prior to the third year. Initially, while the principal grows, the family will provide additional donations to fund each year's award.

Criteria for the award will include: a student from a single-parent family, academic accomplishment, financial need and work experience.

Theresa Utterback was widowed following the untimely death of her husband and as a single parent raised a family of seven children. She worked in the food service department of the Alliance City Schools for over 16 years, retiring in 1981. She was made an honorary member of Alpha Chi Omega Sorority on the Mount Union campus in 1985 and at the time of her death in 1992, she was the housemother at the Sorority house.



# **AHS Athletic Hall of Fame Honors Five New Members**

The Alliance High School Athletic Hall of Fame Committee has selected five new members for the HOF Class of 2012. They are: Kendell Davis-Clark '05, Jan Kehres '04, E J Lilly '99, Doug Duncan '61 and Dawson Curtis '29.

The honorees were introduced prior to the AHS Varsity basketball game on January 25th and honored at a brunch the following morning at the Alliance Elks Club.

The AHS Athletic Hall of Fame was established in 1967 for the preservation of "A Heritage of Alliance High School Athletics." The initial selection committee focused on those athletes who had been out of school for more than ten years. Emphasis was given to the 'old timers' to take advantage of personal knowledge that still existed in the community at that time. Initially, twenty were inducted. This year's five recipients bring the total membership in the AHS Athletic Hall of Fame to 167, ranging from Jesse Beck, a 1911 graduate to this years' induction of Kendell Davis-Clark a 2005 graduate.

The Induction Class of 2012:

### Kendell Davis-Clark, AHS 2005

Kendell excelled in football and track at Alliance High. He is the only AHS four time state champion in track and field, as he repeated wins in the 100 and 200 meter races at Jesse Owens Memorial Track in 2005, leading AHS to the Division II State Championship in his senior year.

In football, Davis-Clark's speed at running back made him a player to be feared. He was constantly marked by opponents who still could not contain him. After graduation, Kendell went on to play Big Ten football graduating from Michigan State after lettering for three years as a defensive back for the Spartans.

### Jan Kehres, AHS 2004

Jan was a three sport star in volleyball, basketball and track. She was all Ohio in volleyball and qualified for regional competition in the middle distances in track three times. She received recognition as All NBC, All Stark County and All District in all three sports.

Jan graduated from Wittenberg University in 2008. At Wittenberg, she stepped into a starting role as a freshman, not only as a player but as a team leader on the court. She earned All-conference in volleyball and was part of a team that finished 38-1 in the 2007 season. Her team made it to the 'Final Four' of the NCAA Division Three tournament.

Jan received her Physicians' Assistant degree from Kettering College. After working in the Pittsburgh area, she is back in the area, employed at Youngstown Orthopedics Associates as a Physicians Assistant in ortho-spine service.

### E J Lilly, AHS 1999

E J was a three year starter for the Aviators, earning All-Ohio honors for football in 1996, 1997 and 1998. He rushed for over 5,000 yards in his high school career and is reputed to be the first player in Stark County history to reach that number.

He also set the single game rushing record for Alliance when he ran for 355 yards in a win against St Thomas Aquinas. Lilly lettered one year in football at University of Cincinnati and competed in six games for Mount Union in 2003.

E J is a 2011 inductee in the Stark County High School Football Hall of Fame.

### Doug Duncan, AHS 1961

Doug led the Aviators on the hard-court for three years, averaging 14.7 points per games for his career. AHS won the sectional tournament twice with him at center. He earned All Ohio basketball honors and was first team All-Stark County. He ranks in the top ten scorers in AHS basketball history with 765 career points, and he was a member of National Honor Society.

### Hall of Fame (Cont.)

Doug competed in basketball at the University of Toledo scoring 11 points in his first varsity game against Notre Dame and later helping the Rockets defeat number one ranked New York University at Madison Square Garden. Doug graduated in 1965 with his BS in Business Administration. He worked in Purchasing and Business Supply Chain Management for B F Goodrich and several other companies at various locations throughout the United States. He currently lives in Williamsburg, Virginia.

Doug and his wife Brenda have three grown children, Scott, Julie and Heather.

### Dawson Curtis, AHS 1929

Dawson was a three sport star at AHS in football, basketball and track. He played end on the football team, was the leading scorer and rebounder on the basketball team, playing center and pole vaulted on the track team. His vault of 11 feet 9 inches in 1928 stood as the school record for fifty years, until 1978. Remember, in the 1920's, only 'bamboo' or 'cane' poles were available.

Curtis continued his athletic career at Mount Union, earning letters in his three high school sports plus golf. His college basketball teams won back-to-back Ohio Athletic Conference championships and he graduated in 1933.

Dawson married his high school sweetheart, Annette Hartzell '29 in 1935. He served in the navy in World War II as a gunnery officer. After the war, he held positions in sales, marketing and product research and development with several local and regional businesses. In 1964 Dawson started a new career teaching industrial arts at Glenwood High School. He received three 'Teacher of the Year' awards before retiring in 1978.

Dawson died in 1983 and Annette in 1996. Their sons, Bob '61 and Tom '65 accepted the award for their father.
