# **Alliance High School Distinguished Alumni**

The Distinguished Alumni Class of 2014 was honored in October last year at an assembly in the Alliance High School auditorium. With the Murals painted by the Class of 1948 overlooking the proceedings, Aaron S Bivins '74, Randall C Hunt '71, Judith Liber '57 and Jeffrey S Russell '80 were inducted.

Each recipient was introduced by Distinguished Alumni chairman Bob Lavery '69 and escorted to the podium by a member of the Committee.

**Aaron S Bivins '74** graduated from the University of Toledo with a BA degree in Art. He earned his teaching certificate and taught Art for ten years at McTigue Jr High School in Toledo. He was then employed as a Health Safety Supervisor for thirty years before retiring in 2011. He has held professional memberships in the Ohio

Watercolor Society, the Toledo Artists Club and the Northwestern Ohio Watercolor Society, where he served as President.

Aaron has painted, demonstrated and served as a juror and instructor of watercolor workshops and classes. He has won Best of Show and First Place Awards across northwestern Ohio. He was featured in the University of Toledo Alumni Magazine in 2010. In addition, the artist was a standout linebacker for the Toledo Rockets football team (see related story, AHS

**Judith Liber '57** graduated from Oberlin College with a degree in Music. She did her graduate study at the University of Illinois and at the Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria. She was principal solo harpist with the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra from 1963 to 2000.

Judy is an internationally renowned teacher. She taught at Tel Aviv University, Jerusalem Academy for Music and Dance and the Accademia Musicale in Florence, Italy. She also served as Music Director and Vice President of the International Harp Contest in Israel and President of its International Jury.

Judy encouraged students today to recognize that life is like a mountain, you have to keep climbing. She acknowledged that the emotion of being included as a Distinguished Alumni and speaking was more nerve racking that performing solo in a concert.

Judy and her husband Vika live in Como Lake, Italy. They have two children and five grandchildren.

**Jeffrey S Russell '80** graduated from the University of Cincinnati with his BS Degree in Civil and Environmental Engineering and earned both his Masters and Doctoral Degrees in Civil Engineering from Purdue University. # **AHS Athletic Hall of Fame**

Alliance High School Athletic Hall of Fame added five new members in 2014. The newest honorees are: Lionel 'Bounce' Grimes 1937, Harold 'Candy' Carroll 1951, Carl Dietz 1955, Aaron Bivins 1974 and Charles Babb 2007. This brings the total membership in the Athletic Hall of Fame to 166.

The Aviator Sports Booster Club sponsored the event last fall with the honorees being introduced at the football game on Friday and formally inducted at a Brunch on Saturday, October 4, 2014.



**Lionel 'Bounce' Grimes '37** played football, basketball, baseball and ran track. Bounce played left end, was captain of the football team his senior year and contributed on the varsity early in his under class years. At 5'11" he played both forward and guard in basketball and was regularly among the high scorers for the Aviators. Playing centerfield in baseball he posted a .431 batting average as a senior and using his speed he contributed to the track team as well. Lionel participated in sports in college but left school three months before graduation to serve his country. He went to Tuskegee and became one of the 'Screaming Eagles.'

Harold 'Candy' Carroll '51 earned three football letters at AHS. In his sophomore season he scored 17 touchdowns as the Aviators finished 9-0-1 (beating Massillon 14-0 and tying Canton McKinley). In his senior year he was named All-Ohio. Candy received a full ride football scholarship to Western Reserve (now Case Western Reserve). While in college he earned eleven varsity letters, four football, four basketball and three baseball. He was drafted by the Cleveland Browns but played only one year of semi-pro football. Dr, Carroll earned his Master's Degree and flourished in an education career with teaching and administration positions in Ohio, Massachusetts and California, retiring in 2001.






Carl Dietz '55 played center and defensive end. He earned three varsity football letters, being named All-Stark County and third team All-Ohio as a senior. He was chosen as the center on the 'All Mel Knowlton Dream Team,' selected by Knowlton himself. Carl received a full football scholarship to Iowa State and later played college football at Bowling Green. After Army service from 1958 to 1960, he served as president of the Alliance Recreation Board for Mayor Jim Puckett and also as President of the Taylorcraft Flying Club. Carl still holds a private pilot certificate. After living in Arkansas, Carl and his wife, Jo, returned to Alliance in 2013. Jo is an ordained minister serving the Emmanuel Lutheran Church in North Georgetown.

Aaron Bivins '74 attended Riverside, Stanton and the high school. He lettered in three sports at AHS: football, wrestling and baseball. As a senior, he was a tri-captain and named to the Review's All-Area Football Team. Receiving a football scholarship to the University of Toledo, Aaron played linebacker and middle guard for the Rockets. He was named to the All-MAC team in 1976 & 1977. He led Toledo in tackles with 186 in 1976 and 180 in 1977 and is the Rockets all time leader in tackles with 508, being named to Toledo's Varsity 'T' Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006. Aaron earned his BA in Art with a teaching certificate. Working in Watercolor, Acrylic and Oil he has countless awards with his painting hung in Art Galleries throughout Ohio and Michigan.





Charles Babb '07 was an electrifying quarterback. He could beat you with his arm or his legs. Charles set records at AHS for career passing yards (5,257), touchdowns (63), total yards (6,514), TD passes in a game (6) and TD passes in a season (20). His career passing yardage ranks third in Stark County history and his 63 TD passes ranks fifteenth in Ohio High School football history. Charles had 323 rushing attempts for 1,257 yards and 13 touchdowns. In his senior year he was named Stark County MVP and to the All-Ohio team. Charles received a full football scholarship to Colgate University.

AHS Athletic Hall of Fame criteria and guidelines include that an athlete must be an Alliance High School graduate, wait five years following graduation before a nomination will be considered and must have distinguished himself or herself in Alliance athletic programs or in support of Alliance athletic programs. Current members of the Hall of Fame committee are Mike Schott '88, Mike Brown (Alliance Review Sports Editor), Steve Diser '60, Greg Donohoe '66, Gary King '73, Ron Kuceyeski '72 and Joe Zelasko '51.

Jeff related that he broke his leg on the first play of the high school football season and advised that setbacks do not have to mean defeat. With encouragement, he was able to overcome the disappointment and frustration, as the team adopted a motto for that year, "hustle for Russell." He channeled his enthusiasm as a fan for the team, organizing the cheering section known as the "bleacher buzzards."

He and his wife Vickie live in Madison, Wisconsin. They have five children.

The Alliance High School Distinguished Alumni Selection Committee was established in 1966, under the chairmanship of Clarence Steffy, to recognize Alliance High School graduates who have made outstanding contributions to society on a local, state, national or international basis.
