

AHS Foundation Presents \$100,000 In Scholarships To Class Of 2017

Forty graduates in the Alliance High School Class of 2017 received scholarship awards through the AHS Foundation totaling more than \$100,000.00. The scholarships presented ranged from \$200.00 for each of eighteen members of the Top Ten percent of the class to \$6,000.00 for five recipients of the John & Roene Klusch Memorial Scholarship, to be distributed at \$1,500.00 per year for four years.

The AHS Foundation adjusted this year's Scholarship Awards to increase the number of graduates receiving its renewable scholarships. The Klusch scholarships were increased from three students to five and the number of AHS renewable recipients rose from four to six. In addition, the Saffell, Utterback and the new 'Days of Glory' renewable scholarships were presented, bringing the total renewable awards to fourteen.

Newly elected President of the AHS Foundation, Patrick Heddleston '82 said, "The AHS Foundation's Board of Trustees felt that increasing the number of scholarships awarded to AHS graduates would enhance our purpose by helping more AHS graduates to continue their education beyond high school. The wider distribution will encourage more

students to take on the increasing costs associated with continuing their education. The Board will continue to try to stay current with the financial demands that graduates face when continuing their education and make adjustments when it seems appropriate."

In addition to the fourteen renewable awards, the AHS Foundation presented an award to each of the top eighteen scholars in the Class of 2017 (Top Ten percent), selected award winners for five non-renewable awards and eleven Named Scholarship awards. The Foundation also administered the endowment funds that were presented to nineteen other Named Scholarship award recipients.

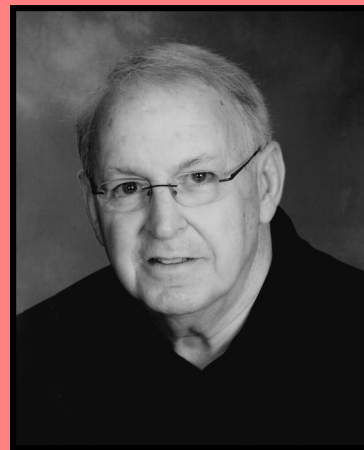
This is the largest amount (\$101,650.00), and the most students presented awards through the AHS Foundation in a single year since its beginnings in 1987, when one student received a \$500.00 scholarship.

The Academic Recognition Committee and the John and Roene Klusch Foundation, in cooperation with the Alliance City Schools, presented the thirtieth annual Academic Recognition Dinner on May 10, 2017 at the University of Mount Union's Hoover-Price Campus Center. The top eighteen students at Alliance High School were honored for their academic achievements, along with their parents and their honored educators.

Travis Alexander, AHS 2004 graduate, was the keynote speaker for the evening event, as well as speaking to an assembly at the high school and visiting with various classes and student representatives during the day. Travis was a part of the Top Ten

percent of the AHS Class of 2004 and received the Elvin Wilson Scholarship to attend Duke University after Alliance High. If others were on your last newsletter via an additional mailing label, but they have a separate address, please send us their current address and we will mail them their own newsletter.

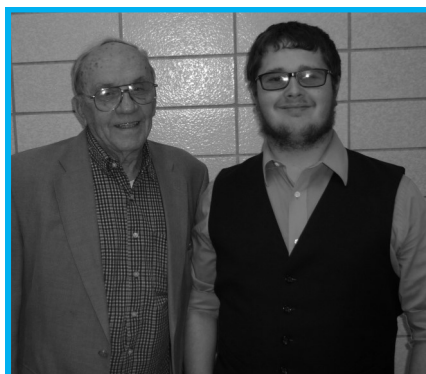
