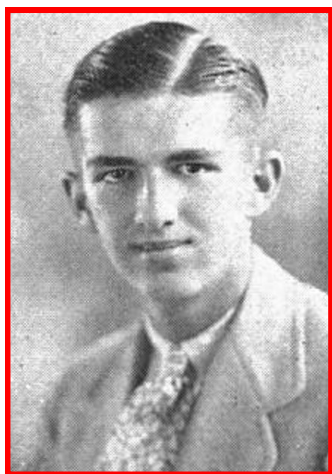




Ray Robert & Eva Mae Peters Reighart Memorial Scholarship

New Scholarship added to the AHS Foundation Family of Awards

The family of Ray Robert and Eva Mae Peters Reighart '27-Ja/'30 has chosen to establish a scholarship in memory of their parents with an endowment gift of \$100,000.00. The first scholarship will be awarded to a member of the AHS graduating

Ray Reighart and Eva Mae Peters both taught in the Alliance school system. Mr. Reighart had aspirations of becoming a doctor, but the loss of his savings during the 'financial crash of 1929' curtailed his plans.

Eva graduated from Alliance High School in 1930, attended Mount Union and earned her degree from Kent State University. She taught for five years at South Liberty Elementary School until she and Ray married in 1938. Eva was forced to resign from teaching in Alliance because, at that time, spouses were not permitted to teach in the same school system. She remained active in the community as part of the Hospital Women's Auxiliary, the Parent-Teachers Association, Alpha Xi Delta Sorority and the Presbyterian Church.

Mr. Reighart graduated from AHS in the January Class of 1927. He graduated from Mount Union and did graduate work at Kent State University. He taught at Alliance High School for his

entire career, retiring after nearly thirty-five years in 1967. Mr. Reighart began teaching German and Biology and later taught Biology, General Science and Driver's Education. He also coached the AHS Golf team and was an advisor to the Science Club. In addition to teaching, he was the golf pro at Sleepy Hollow from 1935 to 1947 and owned and managed the menswear department at the Spring-Holzwarth Store on Main Street.

After a five week illness, Mrs. Reighart died in 1947. Ray raised their two children, Rachel '55 and Ray II '59, as a single parent. Ray Reighart died December 15, 1985.

The Ray Robert & Eva Mae Peters Reighart Memorial Scholarship will be awarded annually to students who are pursuing education beyond high school, demonstrate financial need, academic success, community involvement and school spirit.

The AHS Foundation will administer this endowment fund and select the scholarship recipients. We acknowledge the responsibility and appreciate the confidence that the Reighart family has placed with the Foundation. ✈

The Academic Recognition Committee and the John and Roene Klusch Foundation, in cooperation with the Alliance City Schools, presented the thirty first annual Academic Recognition Dinner on May 9, 2018, at the University of Mount Union's Hoover-Price Campus Center. The eighteen students in Alliance High School's 'Top Ten Percent' were honored for their academic achievements, along with their parents and their honored educators.

2005 AHS Graduates Allison and Amanda Lansell served as keynote speakers for the Academic Recognition Dinner. Allison and Amanda were members of the Top 10% of the AHS Class of 2005 and each went

on to graduate from Case Western Reserve University in 2009. Earlier in the day, they spoke at an assembly at AHS for the entire student body and met 'face-to-face' with a representative group of students from all grade levels for open discussion. The thrust of their presentation was that the students, and all of us, should use our failures to motivate future successes. Failures are hard to talk about, but Allison and Amanda each shared some of their failures. The support they received from friends and family and how they redirected their thinking and energies to succeed the next time were the keynote. "It is our response to failure, what we learn and how we move forward, that can be our paths to success."

The academic achievements of each student were recognized as they were presented a Top Ten Percent certificate, a varsity letter, "Academic A," and a \$200.00 scholarship award from the AHS Foundation. This year, for the first time, student academic standing was calculated through a weighted grade ranking system. The class of 2018 began this process as freshmen and the weighted grade system will be used for future graduation classes. The weighted system gives higher points for specific dual college credit and advanced placement classes and these classes are weighted on the AP scale (5.0 scale). All eighteen students in the Top Ten Percent were recognized with Summa Cum Laude (GPA greater than 4.00). ✈

Attorney Allison Lansell graduated from Case Western Reserve University in 2009, summa cum laude with her BA in sociology and a BA in political science. While at Case she played varsity softball, was president of Alpha Kappa Delta (Sociology Honor's Fraternity) and was active in many other college organizations. She continued her education at the University of Virginia, School of Law, completing her Juris Doctorate in 2012. Allison was managing editor of the Virginia Journal of Social Policy & the Law, commissioner of the North Grounds Softball League and volunteered with the Virginia Innocence Project and the Child Advocacy Clinic. Upon graduation in 2012 Allison moved to Washington DC where she worked in the Special Prosecutions Unit of the Montgomery County (Maryland) State Attorney's Office, served as a clerk in the circuit court focusing on white collar crime and was an associate at the law firm of Rolf, Goffman, Martin, Lang LLP focusing on health care litigation and regulatory compliance. Allison now

lives and works in the Cleveland area where she advises nursing homes in a wide array of legal needs.

Amanda Lansell, MD, earned her BA in Biochemistry and MA in Bioethics from Case Western Reserve University in 2009. While at Case, she was involved in basic science research creating insulin, Gamma Sigma Alpha Greek Honor Society, the Women in Science and Engineering Roundtable and a volunteer tutor. Amanda graduated from the University of Toledo, College of Medicine in 2013, earning her Medical Doctorate. She involved herself in clinical research focusing on care after cardiac arrest, the Emergency Medicine Club and volunteered at a Community Care Clinic, at Diabetic Youth Services and was a peer mentor. In 2016, she completed her Pediatrics Residency at Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital. In 2017 she graduated from Emory University Pediatrics Hospital. Doctor Lansell currently works as a pediatric hospitalist, caring for hospitalized children and delivering newborn babies at three different Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospitals in the Cleveland area. ✈

JENNY KING PHILLIPS '60, LIVED HER LIFE TO THE FULLEST

Jenny King Phillips Alliance High School Class of 1960 passed away in July after an interesting and exciting life of 76 years. She was the daughter of Dr. Robert George King '29, long time community leader in Alliance. Jenny graduated from Simmons College, earned a Master's in psychiatric nursing and a Doctorate in anthropology from Boston University and practiced in family counseling. One of Jenny's brothers was actor, Perry King, her sisters were Mary, an author, and Ruth, an artist, and her brother, Maxwell, was a newspaper editor. Jenny's mother, the former Louise Perkins (Peggy), was the daughter of iconic literary editor Maxwell Perkins, editor of such noted writers as Ernest Hemingway, F. Scott Fitzgerald and Thomas Wolfe.

During her life, Jenny participated in Civil Rights marches in Alabama, the Peace Corps in Africa, visited with Fidel Castro in Cuba while attempting to negotiate a release of Hemingway's manuscripts and letters and she produced, directed and wrote two award winning documentaries on prisoners and prison life. A third production is still untitled and yet to be released.
