Shaun Fontaine, current band director, for a time to meet in the school).

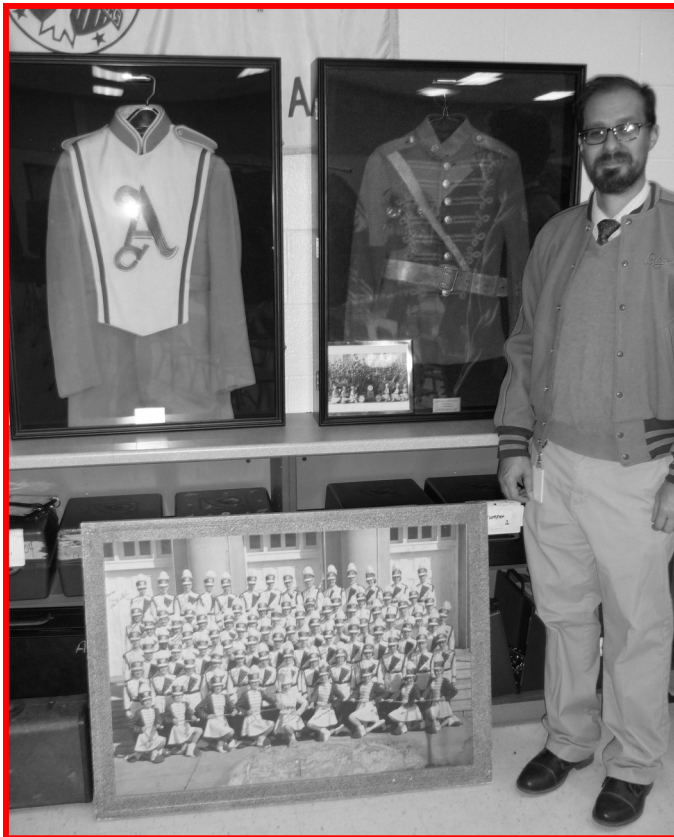

## AHS ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME INDUCTS 34 NEW MEMBERS

In December, 2019, the AHS Athletic Hall of Fame Committee welcomed 34 new members to the Aviator Hall of Fame. Athletic Director Mike Schott '88 appointed Ron Kuceyeski '72 and Ron Cox '65 as Co-Chairmen of the newly re-formed twelve member selection committee. Planning for the event began in the early summer.

The committee looked at existing nominations and reviewed high school records looking for AHS graduates who had attained All-Ohio status in their sport who had not been previously elected.

On December 6, 2019, prior to a varsity basketball game, the newly elected members were introduced to the crowd and the following night an induction ceremony was held in the AHS Auditorium.

On Saturday, the ceremony began with a welcome from Mike Schott and a congratulatory video from David Baker, CEO, Professional Football Hall of Fame. Ron Kuceyeski introduced current Hall of Fame members present and Master of Ceremonies Mike Gallina, Vice President, Organizational Development and Community Development for Aultcare and a former Teacher and Coach in the Alliance City Schools, introduced the AHS Athletic Hall of Fame Class of 2019. Each inductee was presented an engraved plaque by committee members Dick Murray and Ron Kuceyeski and Mr. Gallina spoke of the athletic achievements of each while a picture and summation of their athletic career was displayed electronically on the screens to either side of the auditorium stage. # WHAT'S HAPPENING IN ALLIANCE AND AHS

## TOP GUN WRESTLING TOURNAMENT

The Top Gun Wrestling Tournament continued its thirty-three (33) year successful run. Fifty-one (51) teams from four (4) states. (Ohio, Pennsylvania, West Virginia and Maryland) competed at AHS on January 17 and 18, 2020.

The Aurora Greenmen defended their Top Gun team title, out pointing Point Pleasant, West Virginia, 230 to 224.5. Minerva finished ninth (the highest place for an area team). Alliance finished seventeenth.

For the Aviators, Brailyn Lightner took third place at 160 pounds. Warren Gentile finished third in the 182 pound weight class.

## AHS BASKETBALL

Larry Kukura, AHS Head Basketball Coach since 2005 won his 300th career coaching victory and his 240th at AHS during the 2019-20 season. Kukura surpassed the previous AHS record of 238 victories that Harry Fails posted as Alliance Head Coach between 1972 and 1987.

## AHS SWIMMING

Will Rose 2020 AHS graduate won two OHSA swimming titles in February, winning the 100 meter free-style for the second year in a row and the 50 meter free-style, thus claiming the title, "State's fastest swimmer in the pool."

During his swimming career at Alliance, Will Rose won four (4) State titles (Gold Medals), plus 3 Silver and 1 Bronze. He plans to continue his swimming career at Arizona State University.

Alliance's 4 x 100 meter free-style relay team of seniors Michael Shields, Tommy Gress, Ryan McKnight and Will Rose finished twelfth in the state meet for All-Ohio honors.

## AHS GIRLS WRESTLING

The inaugural Ohio High School Wrestling Coaches state championships were held in February at Hilliard Davidson High School. Over 400 girls from around the state competed in the tournament. Alliance finished in sixteenth place.

Alliance's Mallory Chumat finished, with a 4 and 1 record, in third place in the 131 pound division and Kayley Ross, with a 4-2 record, finished in fifth place at 189 pounds.

## ALLIANCE DISPLAYS BANNERS FOR HOMETOWN HEROES

In 2019, Alliance gave special attention to local military veterans with its Honoring Hometown Heroes project. By mid January of 2020, over 150 statement banners (2 feet wide by 4 feet high) have been installed on light poles along Union Ave and State St.

Sid Zufall brought the suggestion to Alliance after seeing similar recognitions for veterans in places he visited. Community government and local veteran's organizations got involved, and the program took off.

Each statement banner installed will be displayed for two years. The banners have a red, white and blue background, titled 'The City of Alliance Honors,' a picture of the veteran in uniform, name of the veteran, branch of service, the conflict, years of service and any honors received. The sponsor will receive the banner after it has been displayed for two years.

Banners may be ordered at any time. The application form is available at the City of Alliance website ( [www.cityofalliance.com](http://www.cityofalliance.com) ). Placement of the banners is subject to weather conditions and work requirements.

## JEFF HUNTER PRESENTS AT RODMAN LIBRARY

In December 2019, Jeff Hunter visited Alliance from his home in California and presented a program at Rodman Library about his climb of Alaska's Mount Denali in 2018.

Hunter, AHS Class of 2000, made the climb to bring attention to 'front temporal degeneration,' a disease of the brain that has no cure or treatment to slow its progression. Jeff's father, Robert Hunter Jr. '64 died in 2017, suffering from this disease. Through his climbing effort Jeff raised \$30,000.00 for research.

Mount Denali is quite a challenge, with the summit at 20,310 feet above sea level. Temperatures have been recorded as low as minus 118 degrees Fahrenheit. When Hunter made his climb in late May 2018 temperatures dropped to 'only' minus 20 degrees F. ❄️
